

Housing Rules

Visitors

Please be advised that ALL visitors **must** check in at the old front desk or new front desk/host stand in the restaurant. If approved, the visitor may only visit between 10:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. and must be off the property by 6:00 pm.

- Housing Resident must be with their visitor at time of sign in and sign out.
- Only one visitor allowed at a time.
- No overnight visitors are allowed.
- Other employees who are not Housing residents must not visit anyone in Housing.
- Loud music is never acceptable. In addition, quiet hours are from 10:00 p.m. to 10:00 a.m.
- The Laundry Facility is Housing Room 100 and Laundry Hours are 10:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m.

Do Nots

- Cooking is limited. No hot plates, toasters or toaster ovens, BBQ grills, electric skillet and any other high heat producing equipment due to fire hazard.
- Pets
- Illegal drugs
- Dart boards
- Weapons or Firearms
- Candles or Incense
- No hanging anything from fire system
- The water heater closet in bathrooms is not to be used for storage.

- Don't tamper with smoke detectors. Let us know if something is wrong with a smoke detector.
- No nails in the walls. You may use command strips instead
- No smoking in the rooms. This includes e-cigarettes, water vapor and smokeless products.
- Improperly stored food can create a rodent problem. Separate your trash – regular trash and recyclables and dispose of correctly. Don't leave trash bags outside your room. Animals like skunks and bears will get into it and you would be responsible for cleaning it up.

In Addition

Keep rooms neat and orderly. This includes keeping clothes off the floor.

We have weekly inspections. There is a \$20 per room re-inspection fee if you fail inspection. A second inspection results in an additional \$50 fine. A third inspection means forfeit of the rest of your security deposit and loss of housing privileges.

Each is responsible for any damage to their room. If room damage is found, the cost will come out of paycheck.
